They briefed the Hon'ble President regarding the National Summit of HSS, being held in association with GIWA, on the 25 and 26 November in

Historic Summit for Peace and Unity Motivates Pledges by 30,000


Pujya Swamiji was the Chief Guest at the mega Aman Evam Ekta Sammelan (Peace and Unity Summit), organised by the Jamiat Ulamai-Hind, at the Indira Gandhi Stadium on the occasion of their centenary celebrations, with over 30,000 members to spread and share peace, harmony and work together towards a more sustainable/green world.

During the event a historic declaration was made. All assembled unanimously pledged to a historic proclamation, declaring, among other matters, "Islam preaches that the real Jihad means protecting all of humanity against bloodshed and establishing peace. In this spirit, we resolve to strongly condemn terrorism in all its forms.....We herein also declare that violence of any kind against innocent women, children and men—in word or in action—is anti-India, anti-human and anti-Islam. We condemn it, and undertake that we will perform our roles to stop violence, hatred, radicalism and divisive acts wherever we may see it."

The historic declaration was read by Maulana Mahmood Madaniji, Secretary General, Jamiat Ulama I Hind, and he concluded by adding that "The majority of Indian people are peace-loving. Peace and oneness is in the DNA of this country and we pledge today that Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind will stand besides and work together to this end."

Pujya Swamiji lauded the efforts of the organisation for the past 100 years and said, "Time has come for all of us to work together to light the lamp of peace, oneness and unity. No longer should a few people taint an entire religion or an entire community. Today we must all work together as one family to create a strong, resilient nation that illustrates to the world the power of unity admist our diversity. This is truly the need of the hour!" Jathedar Akal Thakt Giani Gurbachan Singhji of the Golden Temple said that all religious texts and founders of religions have stressed on peace and urged people of different faiths to live like a family. He said that India equally belongs to people of all faiths and sects and not to any single community or faith. "Faiths may be different but they all lead to one ultimate truth, much like the purpose of water is to quench thirst no matter if it is called pani, aab or water," he said.

The Declaration adopted at, and ratified, by the conference amidst slogans of 'Hindustan zindabad' said: "In this crucial time...no longer shall words and acts of hatred and division be tolerated. We pledge to unify across all sects, faiths, castes and creeds to lend our hands and hearts for a new era dedicated to greener and more harmonious future, in which all are included, none is excluded and fellowship reigns true."







Sadhvi Bhagawatiji Speaks at the Road to GES Event

In partnership with the Government of the United States of America, NITI Aayog hosted the eighth annual Global Entrepreneurship Summit (GES) in Hyderabad, India during November 28-30, 2017. This was the first time GES was hosted in South Asia, and the event highlighted India's enabling environment for innovation and entrepreneurship – including actions by the government to increase the ease of doing business, eliminating unnecessary regulations, and supporting startups. The theme of the Summit was "Women First, Prosperity for All", highlighting the critical role women play in fostering global growth and prosperity and to celebrate entrepreneurial spirit in all its strength, diversity, and entirety.

The Road to GES (Global Entrepreneuship Summit) was organized at the Taj Mahal Palace in Mumbai, jointly organized by the Government of Maharashtra, Niti Aayog and FICCI, in which leaders from India and the world participated. The Road to GES Series were organized into six interactive entrepreneurial events. These events, aligned with the theme of the main summit "Women First, Prosperity for All", each provided entrepreneurs an opportunity to develop valuable people-topeople relationships, interact with industry leaders and pitch their solutions to investors.

During the inaugural session of the program, GIWA International Secretary and President of the Divine Shakti Foundation Sadhvi Bhagawati Saraswatiji said, "India is a country that believes in the principle of Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam (the world is a family). When we are talking about entrepreneurship in India, we are not talking about our business and profits, but rather what the energetic Prime Minister of India, Narendra Modi, has given as the form of development to everyone. With that vision we move forward. He said that talking about profits does not mean you have to open an NGO or take sanyas, but do business that is beneficial for everyone and that we can supply to the entire world.

Sadhviji also said that the key for success in entrepreneurship is "Three C's": Creativity, Courage, and Connectivity, instead of Competition, and that you should assess your success on these three sources. She emphasized strong participation in the area of women's entrepreneurship.

The importance of volunteering as a means of social change, promotion of equality, and development of sustainable long-term goals was an important theme at this conference.



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


send a deeply meaningful and powerful message to them and to the countries that they represent."

GIWA's Swachh Bharat/Swachh Bihar Yatra Campaign Rallies the Masses for Inspired Change

From Small Villages to Booming Metropolises, GIWA's Clean Revolution Campaign Inspires Every Day to Take Action for a Clean and Healthy India

Thousands of people at the massive Saras Mela Festival in Bihar, India were drawn to the main stage by a matchless vision of the Gods, Shiva, Ganga and Saraswati as they performed in flowing robes. Their performance was unique: compelling the masses to build and use toilets as a call of faith.

The show is part of the Global Interfaith WASH Alliance's historic Clean Revolution Campaign, which is currently in three large Indian states to inspire a clean and healthy India through its 35-person team of social workers, community educators and performers.

The reason is crucial: over 400 million people in India don't have toilets, leading to a public health crisis that results in countless lives lost or impaired due to contaminated water and land. Studies also find that many people who do have toilets are still not using them due to the lack of understanding of their importance. Using its trucks and travelling theatres, GIWA's Clean Revolution campaign is igniting new waves of understanding, so that the cause for clean sanitation can be taken up by all as a call of faith.

And the campaign is working. According to evaluations, over 90% of participants agree afterwards that they are more likely to compel their neighbours to build and use toilets as a result of the multi-day programme, which includes stage shows, community meetings, children's rallies, classes for community motivators and masons and more.

GIWA's unique approach interweaves faith-based messaging with conventional interventions in order to leverage impact. Understanding that on-ground change is essential in light of rapidly-approaching SBM and deadlines, GIWA's Swachh Bihar Yatra is taking into account the entire landscape: from the grand level of mass events to ground level meetings, early-morning interventions and more.

Swachh Bihar Yatra Activities Include:

- Dynamic live performances
- Lively audience interactions
- The screening of motivational videos featuring India's foremost faith leaders
- CLTS triggering techniques
- Children's rallies and marches
- Early-morning follow-ups/individual discussions
- Community meetings
- Planning sessions with community leaders
- Mass and personal pledges
- Special events
- Data collection for planning of follow-up interventions in
- coordination with relevant governmental agencies
- and more

To strengthen the campaign's on-ground impact, a special GIWA team will also provide follow-up classes to help promote the fast and effective building of toilets. These will include:

- CLTS (Community-Led Total Sanitation) triggering activities
- Community outreach training for community leaders and officials
- The training of local faith leaders
- The training of women as toilet masons for their communities
- and more

As an intriguing feature of the programme is the screening of videos of some of India's foremost faith leaders, as they share their inspirational words on the importance of toilets and cleanliness for the health of our children and the future of India.

Said Balamurugan D., Chief Executive Officer-Cum-Mission Director, LSBA (SBM Bihar), "Whatever has been done by GIWA has proven to be very good because each method has a different effect... the help that has been received through GIWA's efforts has been every effective and useful in creating awareness about sanitation."

Said Sadhvi Bhagawati Saraswatiji, GIWA Secretary General, "we are so happy to see village gates thrown open for our Swachh Bharat Yatra, which is touching the hearts of countless people as it travels through the state. It shows the faith-based approach can make the difference that is needed."

She said, "Our scriptures and ancient rishis told us that the mind is the source of both our bondage and our freedom -- that pertains both to our own spiritual lives and the life of our planet. As the mind yells "more, more," industries race to supply to our demand, thereby destroying our water, land and air. Spirituality teaches us Santushti contentment, how we can be deeply content in our inner world so we don't have to destroy the outer world in our attempt to fill our emptiness."

She spoke about the role of the meat industry on global warming and the world's water resources. She emphasized, "We do not have a global water shortage, food shortage or land shortage. We have a global consciousness shortage, and spirituality is that which should restore and revitalize our consciousness so we can truly live as one global, healthy family."

International **Society for Gene & Cell Therapy Conference** in **Bangalore**





Recognizing the Ganga itself for its cultural heritage would be an important next step towards preserving the riverine system, which supports some 500 million human lives.

Every day, some 3 billion litres of sewage and one billion litres of toxic chemicals contaminate the river, leading to patriotic calls to action for its revitalization from the highest levels of govern-

The proposal was cordially presented to Hon'ble Shri Mahesh Sharmaji, who expressed his appreciation of the noble concept and noted that the Ganga represents an important cultural heritage for our nation and our world.

Prior to this meeting, the concept was discussed with the Executive Director of UNSECO, Ms. Irina Bokova, when she and Pujya Swamiji were in Istanbul for the World Humanitarian Summit.




